

# Back to School 2017, Information and Forms

Please see below details of our back to school information. All information can be accessed on our website at [www.stanthony.k12.mn.us/hs](http://www.stanthony.k12.mn.us/hs) Please review this form as a checklist as to what is necessary for your child's upcoming school year. Your child's schedule will be available through your parent portal access or their direct link to Infinite Campus. Reminder to your child to access their portal: username is student id number; password is first and last name initials (lower case) followed by 6-digit birthdate.

1. **Bell Schedule '17 -'18:** This form outlines the class periods throughout the school day and their starting and ending times.
2. **Principal Terry's Letter of Welcome Back**
3. **Fall Open House Info- NOTE DATE IS BEFORE START OF SCHOOL (August 30).** There is also a blank schedule for you to fill out in order to follow your student's schedule.
4. **Military Recruiters Disclosure for 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> graders :** High schools are required to release the names, addresses and telephone number(s) of students in grades 11 and 12 to military recruiters, unless their parents have refused to release this data to military recruiting officers. The school is giving parents and students the notice of the right to refuse release of this data to military recruiting officers. To do this, please print out this form and return it to the High School Office by October 15, 2017.
5. **HS Supplies '17-'18:** This is a general list of supplies; more details on specific needs for each course will be included in the class syllabus.
6. **Free/Reduced Lunch Paperwork for 2017:** Families who have received free and reduced meals in the past will need to reapply each year. If you received this benefit last year, it will continue for 30 days. By October 1, you will need to submit up-to-date paperwork. Please print out the new form if you believe you may qualify for this benefit. Completed forms can be submitted to the High School Office.
7. **Instruction and Income Guidelines for Free and Reduced Lunches:** These instructions can be helpful as you complete the free/reduced lunch paperwork.
8. **Student Nutrition News '17-'18:** This form explains the procedures for making lunch payments, accessing balances, meal pricing, etc.
9. **September Menu:** Subsequent month menus will be available on line only with daily menus printed in announcements.

- 10. Photo information:** Lifetouch Studios will be at school taking school photos on **Monday, September 18**. You may order a photo packages on line or at the time of the photo shoot. See the website under “photo information” for more details.
- 11. Local Field Trip Form ACCESS ONLINE ONLY:** This form is to be returned ONLY if parents wish to opt out, not allowing your child to participate in walking field trips.
- 12. '17-'18 Calendar at a glance:** This one-page calendar gives a quick overview to the school year dates.
- 13. Senior Letter Addressing Yearbook Photo Submission:** All students in 12<sup>th</sup> grade should pay specific attention to this document which provides deadline for submission of senior photos as well as shout out information and additional yearbook photos.

**Locker info: Most of the students in grades 10, 11, and 12 will retain the same locker as last year with the exception of a few students who were moved to accommodate office needs.** Note: 9<sup>th</sup> grade student lockers are assigned on all three floors.
