The Huskies Diamond Club Scholarship Application must be completed and submitted to Mrs. Kurak in the Guidance Office by March 29, 2017 by 3pm. This application will be combined with the General Application. Late applications will not be accepted.

Huskies Diamond Club Scholarship Qualification Criteria:

- Minimum of a 3.2 GPA
- Applicant must have participated and completed 4* years of high school softball.
- Applicant must have participated actively in fundraising for the organization, over the 4* years while in the softball program. (Fundraising participation includes selling tickets for Softball Fundraising events such as Huskies Diamond Club Spaghetti Dinner, Unofficial ticket sale and the Flower Fundraiser).
- Applicant must be accepted full time in an undergraduate program leading to a bachelor's degree or associate's degree at an accredited college or university in the Fall of 2017.
- The scholarship will be deposited directly to the accredited college/university the applicant will be attending in the Fall of 2017.
- *If applicant was not enrolled in the district for 4 full years, applicant must have played softball and met all other requirements for the duration of their in-district, eligible, high school softball career.

*Awards will be made by board based on overall contribution to Softball program.
