FOSTER, BREVER AND WEHRLY, PLLC: An all-around student with a strong academic background, who has participated, extra-curricular activities, good citizenship, good character and has provided service to the school. The applicant should be attending college with top priorities being St. John's University or College of St. Benedict (MN) with an interest in pre-law studies.	\$500	General and Foster, Brever and Wehrly, PLLC applications
FOSTER FAMILY IN HONOR OF DAN AND KATE FOSTER: Participant on the speech team, National Honor Society or Theater	\$1,000	General Application
HOCKERT & SROGA, LLC CPA: Would like someone that is leaning towards an accounting degree at any college, would prefer a resident student. DOES NOT have to be need basis, should maintain a "B" average or better, participated in one or more service projects, a short statement as to why they think that they deserve this scholarship.	\$1,000	General and Hockert & Sroga applications
HUSKIES DIAMOND CLUB SOFTBALL: Minimum 2.9 GPA; have participated in and finished each of the 4 years of HS softball; accepted FT in an accredited college; applicant and/or family must have participated in Diamond Club fundraisers (dinner, flower sales)	TBD	General and Huskies Diamond Club applications
JESSICA PETRICK AXTEL MEMORIAL: A student who truly shows the spirit of the music department, at least student involved in choir. Furthering their education in music is not a criterion for the award, but could be involved in the decision.	\$1,500 Total	General Application
JORDAN L. HOLT MEMORIAL: This scholarship is particularly aimed to help those who have worked to overcome any difficulties they may have had in their lives. This individual will have a strong desire and commitment for success, an interest in this world and their place within it, a unique perspective on life, a sense of humor, be an independent spirit, and have financial need, yet because of past obstacles or life challenges might not be eligible for other types of assistance.	\$1,000	General and Jordan L. Holt Memorial Scholarship applications
JULI Mc DANIEL MEMORIAL: Applicant must be accepted and enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution. Qualities to be considered in the evaluation process include: leadership, civic mindedness, being inspired to make a difference.	\$3,000	General and Juli Mc Daniel applications

LETTERWINNERS: One Huskie Court Club, One Huskie Football. Qualifications: 1) Participation in a sport senior year; 2) Planning to attend a college or vocational school; 3) financial need.	\$500 each 2 scholarships (1 girl/1 boy)	General and Letterwinners applications
LORENO FAMILY: These scholarships will be awarded to students who are planning to attend trade school. Essay is required to explain their work ethic and why this trade was chosen. Also essay should include any jobs they have had, sports or clubs they have participated in and volunteer work they may have done.	\$1,000 2 scholarships	General and Loreno Family applications
McREAVY / UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA: The applicant must be planning to attend the Minneapolis or St. Paul Campus of the University of Minnesota. Must have a "B" average. Qualified seniors will be judged on the basis of their involvement with athletics (participant or spectator), other extra-curricular activities and service to the school. Need may also be a consideration. An essay must be included with application.	\$1,000 each: (2 scholarships: 1 female, 1 male)	General and McReavy/U of M applications
N.E. MPLS KIWANIS COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD: Seniors must be living NE Mpls. Preference given to those who have a relationship with a Kiwanis from the NE Kiwanis Club.	\$1,000	General and N.E. Kiwanis applications
N.E. LIONS FOUNDATION: Must be a NE Mpls resident with a GPA of 2.5+. One scholarship will be provided to a senior attending trade school.	\$500 4 scholarships	The General and NE Lions applications
NEW BRIGHTON/MOUNDS VIEW ROTARY CLUB: Applicants must be a resident of New Brighton or Mounds View. Please attach a statement describing how you are serving your family, school, community, church, nation and/or world. Need two adults who have knowledge of some of the contributions described in your application statement.	\$1,500	General and Rotary applications
NHS SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP: Student has to show active involvement in an extra-curricular service organization. (HS organizations not included.)	\$500	General and NHS applications
PARK CONSTRUCTION: Minimum 3.0 GPA, Financial need basis, Scholarship is good for a 2-4 year degree at any University/College/Votech in the field of construction or engineering. Examples: Civil Engineering, Construction Engineering, Construction Management, Drafting, Mechanic, Welding etc.	\$1,000	General and Park Construction applications
SANBE: The applicant plans to attend college or vocational school and has demonstrated voluntary service to the community. An essay describing the applicant's community service work while in high school and how the applicant sees himself/herself contributing to their community in the future. Attach two letters of support from adults who have knowledge of the applicant's contributions to the community.	\$500	General and SANBE applications
SAVHS RETIRED TEACHERS: Students must attend a two or four year college and have a preference towards education.	\$500	General Application

SAV CHAMBER OF COMMERCE: 1) achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0; 2) undertake a course of study at an accredited educational institution (college university, trade, or technical school, etc.); 3) intend to undertake a course of study with either a major or minor in business or business-related courses, or may pursue a non-business related course of study but intends to own or operate a business related to their course of study; 4) include with application a short statement outlining their post-educational vocational business interests with respect to No. 3 above. The scholarship will be awarded in check form, payable to the recipient and school at which the scholarship is to be applied. Proof of enrollment must be submitted.	\$1,000 2 scholarships	General and SAV Chamber of Commerce applications
SA COMMUNITY THEATER (SACT): This scholarship will be awarded to one student who has participated in theater arts either as an actor or member of a backstage or technical crew either at St. Anthony Village High School or in greater community productions during his/her high school years. Special consideration will be given to students who plan to pursue a theater-related degree.	\$500	General and SACT applications
SAVHS CROSS COUNTRY: Any male or female CC runner who has demonstrated the STA Cross Country Points of Emphasis: Be a true student/athlete; be prepared to work hard, be willing to work as a team, always working towards individual improvement, and helping other improve and be wiling to have fun.	\$200	General Application
SA FIRE DEPT/BILL MYERS MEMORIAL PUBLIC SAFETY: Students wanting to enter a public safety career such as fire service, emergency medical service, police department, health care education; intending to go to a two or four year school. GPA requirement at least 2.0. Must be involved in school activities.	\$1,000	General and SAV Fire Dept/Bill Myers Memorial applications
SAV KIWANIS: <u>FIRST</u> scholarship, applicant must have been a Key Club Member and be planning to attend a college or trade school. <u>SECOND</u> scholarship, will be open to anyone. Applicants for both scholarships will be judged on the basis of character, citizenship, service to the school and community and financial need.	\$1,250 2 scholarships	General and St. Anthony Kiwanis applications
SA HEALTH CARE - SENIOR LIVING: Applicants with a strong academic background, planning on a nursing degree (RN or LPN), volunteer work in both school and the community.	\$500 1 scholarship	General and St. Anthony Senior Living applications
SAVHS STUDENT COUNCIL: Applicants must have displayed 3 of 4 of the following qualities: academics, leadership, arts, service.	\$500	General and Student Counsel applications
SAV EDUCATION ASSOCIATION (SAVEA): Applicants must be going on to college and considering a career in teaching. Must be in top 40% of the class. Applicants will be judged on their extra-curricular activities, outstanding achievements, academic record and need.	\$500 each 3 scholarships	General and SAVEA applications
SLP/STA BOYS SOCCER BOOSTER: Senior soccer player, GPA	\$500	General application
SLP/STA GIRLS SOCCER BOOSTER: Senior soccer player, GPA	\$500	General application

WOMEN IN STEM: Identifies as female, enrolled in a 2-year or 4-year STEM program, 3.0 minimum GPA.	\$750 each	General and Women in STEM applications
